### THE SITUATION IN BEIRUT

This past week, Beirut Port was hit with a devastating explosion.

The blast wave levelled buildings near the port and caused extensive damage over much of the rest of the capital, which is home to two million people. Hospitals were quickly overwhelmed.

The tragedy has resulted in around 200 dead so far and 5,000 injured. More than 300,000 people have been displaced from their homes. According to UNICEF, 100,000 of those are children.

The lebanese people are shocked and traumatized, being seperated from their families, with many still missing. The explosion destroyed three hospitals and severely damaged two more, further depending the critical financial and pandemic-related situation.

Add to that the psychological trauma this blast has left behind. Children who are now traumatized, scared of any loud sound they hear. Children and families who survived but now see death in their dreams. A whole nation broken trying to make sense of this murderous blast. A whole nation who needs to heal while they clean the streets of their beloved city, the homes of their families and friends and neighbors; and splitting their food with others in need. A nation that, in its devastation, is coming together yet needs all the help it can get to rebuild the homes and the lives of the people who lost it all. Lebanon's economic crisis began in November 2019 and continues to worsen till present day. Toppled with COVID-19, the Lebanese were pushed into a state of deep poverty. The disastrous explosion that took place has rendered hundreds of thousands homeless, in need of food, water, house repair, medical help, and mental support.
